TSCA Compliance Declaration

ROSS CONTROLS®, ROSS DECCO®, and Automatic Valve Industrial (collectively “ROSS”) are manufacturers of pneumatic and hydraulic valves, controls systems, and related products for the fluid power industry.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in pursuit of its mission to protect human health and the environment, has released final rules under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) that will reduce exposure to the five chemicals listed below that are classified as persistent, bio-accumulative, and toxic (PBT).

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl) phenol (2,4,6-TIBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

ROSS has reviewed its production processes and the processes of its key suppliers and, with respect to the chemicals listed above, can confirm TSCA compliance.

ROSS is committed to be an environmentally and socially responsible world-class pneumatic systems manufacturer. To this end, ROSS continues to work within its supply chain to ensure TSCA compliance.

ROSS ensures compliance by:

- Strictly controlling the materials and finishes that are used in its products
- Periodic audits of suppliers to ensure compliance
- Periodic analysis, on an as-needed basis, of products

ROSS expects its suppliers to undertake commercially reasonable due diligence within their respective supply chains to ensure restricted substances supplied to ROSS do not exceed TSCA threshold limits. In addition, ROSS expects its suppliers to conduct worldwide operations in a manner that is environmentally responsible.
